Corequisites: Student should be studying at least 7th grade math

Required Materials: Paper and pencil/pen. Lab notebook and anatomy coloring book will be provided.

Class Format: Class time will be used to introduce new material through lecture/discussion and labs/demonstrations. Reading and homework assignments are to be done through the week between classes.
